By offering preventive medical care, they hope to help people avoid potential, costly health problems down the line. Services available at the health fair include children's services such as immunizations, exams, dental checks and vision screenings; women's health screenings, including pap screenings and mammograms; and cholesterol and diabetes screenings.
