

CHAMBERS ROAD WIDENING DESIGN

105th Ave to 116th Ave

Project Description

The City of Commerce City Public Works Department has begun design to widen Chambers Road between 105th (east entrance of Reunion Marketplace) and 116th Avenues. In the city's Transportation Plan of 2010, this stretch of Chambers Road was recommended for widening to provide capacity improvements while enhancing driving, biking, and pedestrian safety.

Roadway Design: January 2025 – September 2025

Right of Way Appraisal & Acquisition: June 2025 –

Next Public Meeting: Fall 2025

Construction: Dependent on funding

Improvements



Widening road to two vehicle lanes in each direction, adding a center new turn lanes.



Curb and gutter, a detached sidewalk on the west side of the roadway, and raised median, and trail extensions along the east side.



A new bridge over Second Creek to accommodate a 100-year flood event.
