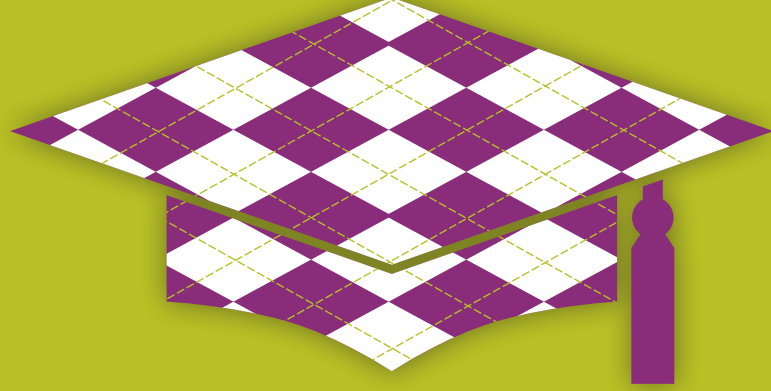

Quality Community Foundation Scholarship Program
